- 1. My soul sings out your greatness, O God. My spirit exults because you save me.
- 2. Because of your tenderness to your servant, from this day forth ev'ry age will call me blest. *Acclamation*
- 3. You have worked wonders for me. Your name is holy, O God.
- 4. Your love is sure from age to age, reaching all who revere You. *Acclamation*
- 5. You show forth the strength of your justice, and scatter the arrogant of heart.
- 6. You bring down the power of tyrants, and raise up the wretched of the earth. *Acclamation*
- 7. You feed the starving with plenty, but send the rich away empty.
- 8. You come to the help of Israel, your servant, remembering your promised love. *Acclamation*
- 9. You have remembered your age-long mercy, to Abraham and Sarah, and their people, forever.
- 10. We praise you, Creator, Word, and Holy Spirit, both now and forever, world without end. *Acclamation & repeat Antiphon*
