1. (may be sung as an exchange between bride and groom.)

2. (suggests the participation of the assembly)

Share our joy, sing with us; deep the call to live. May our days, bright with hope, make more clear our choice. Long and winding roads we'll follow, knowing certainly peace must be our home.
